

"I had not wanted this to be solely an American program,"

"In each country, bi-national commissions are to develop the kind of program that make sense to them, i.e. the types of students, or teachers and professors, should be selected, and what kind of research work should be conducted."

Cultural agreement between French and American governments creating the U. S. Educational Commission for France

May 7, 1965 - bilateral financing

 - Research Scholars
 - University Administrators



Advanced Student Program: Grants to U.S. students for graduate study and/or research or teaching assistantships abroad.

Fulbright-Ecole normale supérieure de Cachan Fulbright-French Government Teaching Assistantship



- Advanced Student Program:
 - Priority for degree seeking programs (Master 1 or Master 2, ENS Cachan)
 - Individual Research projects
 - Scientific Internships (stagiaire) if enrolled in degree seeking program
 - English Teaching Assistantships (10 in France)



- English Teaching Assistantships
 - Target: socio-economically and culturally underserved students, ZEP High Schools
 - Community Service/Project => Volunteering







Research Scholar program:

Grants for U.S. college and university post-docs and faculty, as well as for professionals and independent scholars, to lecture and/or conduct research.

Includes Fulbright-Tocqueville Distinguished Chair program, traditional Research Scholar program, EHESS, regional programs with Alsace, Aquitaine, Nord Pas de Calais, and Rhône-Alpes
